

Tips For Installation

Considerations

When choosing any piece within our Low Fired Clay collection, consideration must be given to ensure the piece is suitable for its intended application.

Gather Co is pleased to provide direction as an addition to the product sale. In all cases, we recommend following the advice of qualified and experienced horticulturalist or landscape professional.

The following instruction is to be used in conjunction with the relevant Australian Standards

Gather Co has partnered with industry leaders to supply the very best in vital accessories to our Low Fired Clay collection. When using these accessories, always follow the manufactures specifications.

Deciding on a selection from our Feature Décor range must include the following considerations:

- Drainage Hole
- Waterproofing
- Stability
- EverGrow Pot Bags
- Seepage & Product Variation

Drainage Hole

Certain pieces within the Low Fired Clay collection

do not come with drainage holes. Where this is the case, it's the installers responsibility to drill the necessary opening if required. Ensure this task is undertaken by a qualified trade professional. We suggest using a battery-operated drill with an appropriate masonry bit. Rotate slowly and DO NOT use the hammer function. The planter's structural integrity may be compromised if this procedure is not followed correctly.

Waterproofing

Terracotta is a notoriously porous and absorbent material. Over time, this characteristic has allowed leaching to naturally transpire across many pieces within our Low Fired Clay collection. Gather Co does not consider this condition to be a defect. Furthermore, it must be understood that new leaching may develop or continue to advance. Action can be taken to help reduce future leaching, should this be the customers preference. We recommend the application of HydroBan by Laticrete to the internal surface of the feature piece. <u>DO NOT</u> apply HydroBan to the outside of the piece as this will significantly change the products aesthetic. Two coats must be applied. Please refer to the HydroBan Product Data Sheet for full directions or contact them directly:

Stability

Gather Co has developed custom steel tripod stands as an accessory to aid in the stability of selected Low Fired Clay items. The application of these stands does not eliminate the necessity to address the following considerations.

- Surfaces hosting Low Fired Clay pieces must be appropriate.
- It is essential to ensure the intended site is level, accessible, durable and rated to support the significant weight associated with both empty and planted-out pieces.
- Exposure to various elements including wind must be accounted for, as this can cause toppling
- Pedestrian thoroughfares, domestic animals and children may also present potential triggers for toppling

Pot Bags

Gather Co has partnered with EverGrow New Zealand to develop a range of purpose-built Pot Bags. These synthetic vessels are specifically designed to restrict and restrain growing roots. This in turn manages excess load and structural pressure applied to the host Feature Décor piece. We highly recommend the application of EverGrow Pot Bags whenever planting-out any of Gather Co's Feature Decor products. Seepage

Many pieces within the Feature Décor range have formally hosted various food materials including olives, grains, grapes and more. The residue of this activity may present a source of stains.

Even after the application of HydroBan by Laticrete, leaching can continue to advance. This may result in seepage causing discolouration to surrounding surfaces. Gather Co takes no responsibility for stains caused as a result of this natural seepage. Practical steps must be taken to manage or accept the inevitable effects of runoff which, is exaggerated over time as plants are watered, or the piece is exposed to rain.

Product Variation

Our Low Fired Clay collection includes handmade - antique, vintage and recycled products. Please expect considerable variation in size, shape, texture, colour and condition. This variation has been accounted for during the sourcing process and Gather Co believes that it is precisely this unique character that gives each piece its authentic appeal

We have attempted to group products according to aligning characteristics but, it must be understood that this is a guide only. Please request further details when making any selections to ensure your expectations are met.
